- 1. Cutting Instructions From purple print cut (2) 8–7/8" x 8–7/8" squares

- "**Pumpkin Square**" by Rhonda McCray, pg 46
- 1. In the cutting of the "center block" you need a total of 8 (not 10) 2-3/8" squares from the assorted green prints (which will then be cut in half diagonally which is part of the pattern already).
- 2. You also will need two 2-3/8" black squares "(A)" cut in half diagonally to finish the center section In squaring up the pieces: the flying geese of the center unit should square up to 1-5/8" x 2-3/4", the center unit itself should be squared up to 10".
- 3. Pumpkin A should square up to 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".
- 4. Pumpkin B should square up to $4" \times 4-1/2"$.
- 5. Pumpkin C should square up to 4" x 4-1/2"
- 6. Pumpkin D should square up to 3" x 4-1/2". (Finished measurements were given instead of squared-up measurements)
- 7. In the cutting instructions you are cutting "rectangles" and in the piecing instructions those same pieces are mistakenly referred to as "squares".
