 1. For the side scrap blocks, add one more 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strip, so that the side borders will measure 4" x13" finished, not 4" x 12" as shown in the pattern!

1. First sentence of Instructions says to cut 4 strips, 2.5"x40.5", and set aside. These strips need to be 2" wide, not 2.5", in order to finish at 1.5" and match up with the side borders of half-square triangles.

- **"Willow Street"** by Jenifer Gaston, pg 34

1. Cutting: From the background strips, sub-cut 20 (not 30) 1-1/2" squares, and 10 2-1/2" squares From the green strips, sub-cut 10 2-1/2" squares
2. Sewing: Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 10 2-1/2" squares. Lay each on top of a green 2-1/2" square, right sides together. After you make the 20 half-square triangle units, trim them to 1-1/2" square.
