

Curly Sheep Ornament

The Woolen Willow

Cut the body and tail from off-white wool. Cut head and ears from black wool.

Sew a head piece to each body piece with right sides together. Then, with right sides together stitch body pieces together, allowing an opening to turn & stuff. Turn and stuff; slip stitch opening shut.

Stitch ears and tail into place.

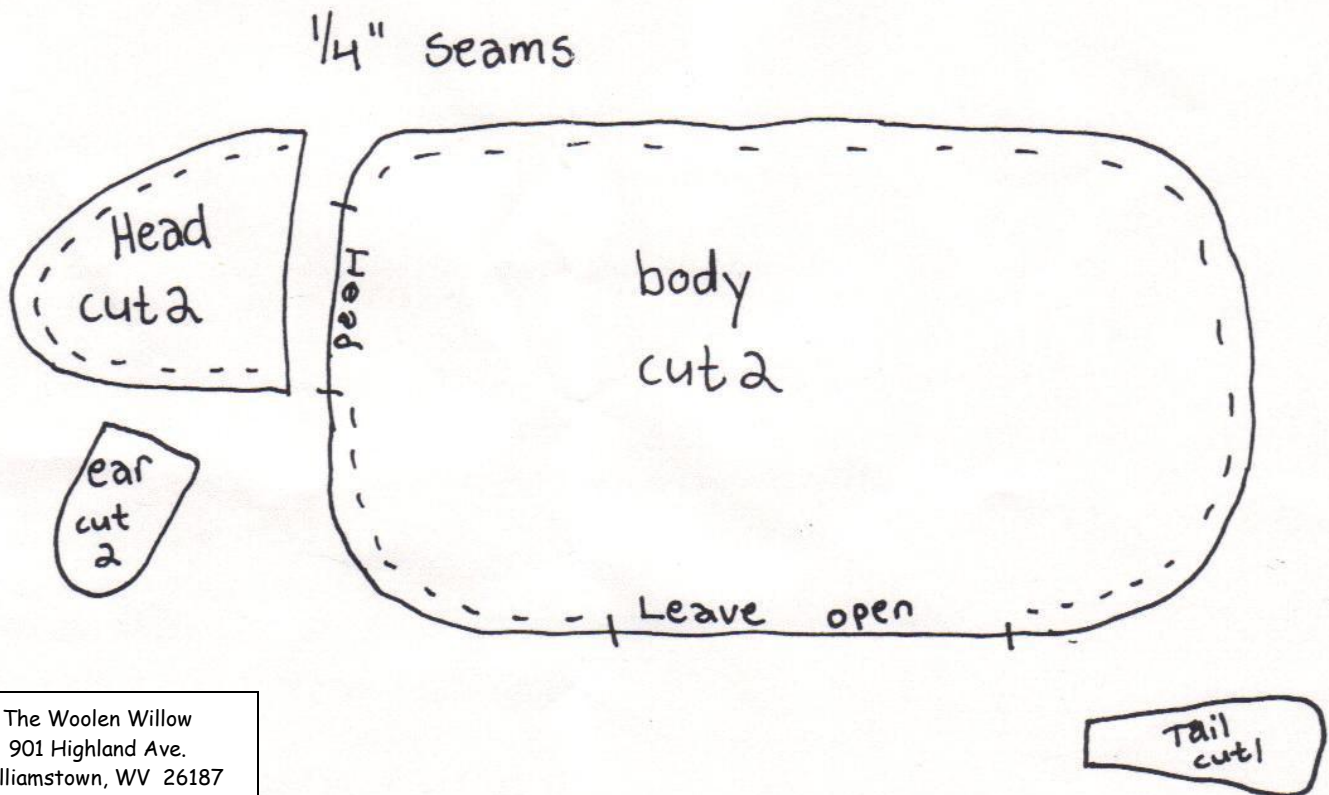
Cut 4 twigs for legs, about 2.5" long each.



Snip tiny holes in body to glue legs into, using a glue gun or Tacky glue. Add curly hair by needle felting your stuffed sheep all over!

Make a wreath for his neck by grunging up a silver pipe cleaner with brown or black paint; slip on a rusty jingle bell. Twist with a piece of wired greenery and wrap around sheep's neck. With a needle & thread, stitch a mouth and nose, and make a loop from his back to hang him on your tree.
