Snowman & Crow Ornament

Materials:

Cream Wool for Head, fat 1/8
Orange Wool for nose, 4"x4" square
Scraps for eyes
Brown textured wool for mouth, $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 14" strip
Black wool for crow body, 8"x 6"
Scrap of dark coordinating wool for crow wings

Cut 4 snowman head pieces using the pattern and cream wool. Sew the 4 pieces together at sides, leaving a small opening for turning and stuffing. Stuff and stitch closed. Using pattern piece, cut nose from orange wool, fold and sew side seam. Stuff and whipstitch to snowman head. Stitch on eye pieces. Use a running stitch up the length of the strip of brown wool and pull to gather up like a caterpillar. Secure thread and knot. Use straight pins to hold gathered (shirred) piece in place for mouth and whip stitch into place. Sew two crow body pieces (black wool) together leaving opening. Turn & stuff. Stitch closed and stitch to top of snowman's head. Stitch two wings on crow just along top edge of wing piece. Use thread to make loop for hanging. Enjoy!

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
