Winter Sampler Finishing Instructions

Applique Blocks: Cut background squares 4"x4". Do your stitchin', then trim down the blocks to match up with the nine patches as described below for quilt assembly!

Materials:

2" x WOF (width of fabric) of Red, Blue, Gold and brown prints for Nine-patch blocks 5/8 yd of brown print for setting triangles, corners and border 7" brown print for binding

Directions

Sub-cut the 2" x WOF strips to measure 1-5/8" x WOF, and then cut each in half to measure 1-5/8" x 22" (22" is approximate)

Sew strips in this manner.... Red, Gold, Blue


Sub-cut strip set into twelve 1-5/8" sections

Cut the brown and gold strips in half again to measure 1-5/8" x 11" (11" approximate)

Sew strips in this manner..... Gold,

Sub-cut strip set into Six 1-5/8" sections

Sew the sections together to make Nine-Patch Blocks with the Gold/brown/gold unit in the middle.

From the borders and setting triangle fabric, cut a 6-1/8" strip WOF. Open up the strip and from one end cut three 6 1/8" squares. Sub-cut the squares diagonally into fourths to make four triangles from each square. These are your setting triangles. You will need 10.

From the rest of the strip, cut two 3-3/8" squares, then sub-cut once diagonally to make four triangles for the corners.

Lay out the stitched blocks, nine-patch blocks and triangles following the picture for placement. Sew together in diagonal rows, pressing seams as you go. Trim all around using large ruler to square up the quilt.

From the border print, cut three 4-1/2'' strips WOF. Sew one strip to the right side of the quilt, press and trim. Use the piece you trimmed off to sew onto the left side, press and trim. With the remaining two strips sew one to the top and one to the bottom, press and trim.

Layer with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind and enjoy!
